

INTO NEWCASTLE UNIVERSITY INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS 2020-21

NCL International Foundation Scholarships 2020-21

The INTO NCL International Foundation Scholarships are 'match funded' Joint Venture scholarships whereby 50% of the award is deducted from the INTO foundation programme tuition fee and the remaining 50% will be discounted by Newcastle University if the student successfully progresses to their chosen Bachelors programme.

How much are the awards worth?

The scholarships will be worth either 20K or 10K.

Value	INTO NCL contribution (deducted from Foundation Tuition Fee)	Newcastle University contribution (deducted from First year Bachelors fee)
20000 Award	10000GBP	10000GBP
10000 Award	5000GBP	5000GBP

Who is eligible?

- The awards are only available to <u>new</u> International Foundation students
- The second tranche will only be awarded if the student successfully progresses to Newcastle University.

Selection Criteria

- Students can be selected and nominated by the appropriate regional office.
- Students must be *academically high performing* students with potential to be future student ambassadors.
- Where a greater region holds multiple awards they should be allocated to different Foundation Programmes if possible.
- Awards can be allocated for September 2020 or January 2021 intakes.
- Awards cannot be transferred to another Institution.
- Awards are not transferable to another recruitment year.

Can the awards be combined with other foundation or progressor scholarships?

• The International Foundation Scholarship *cannot* be combined with other awards – including regional scholarships or other university progressor scholarships.

Nominations

- Nominations must be made on the *International Foundation Scholarship Nomination Form* and submitted to the Centre for approval by the published date (*see below*).
- If nominations are not received by this date awards may be transferred to another region.
- Successful students will receive a confirmation letter from NCL and must confirm within two weeks of receipt of the letter.

When is the closing date?

Regional Offices should select and nominate recipients by:

- <u>30 June 2020</u> for September 2020 entry; and
- <u>30 November 2020</u> for January 2021 entry.
