All students who apply for eligible courses will be automatically assessed for the scholarship, and will be advised of the outcome. There is no need to complete a scholarship application form.

Scholarship value

20% off tuition fees for the normal duration of your degree.[#]

Eligibility criteria

Applicants must:

- be prospective international students enrolling in any of the following Deakin courses: Master of Public Health; Master of Health and Human Services Management; Master of Health Economics; Master of Health Promotion; Master of Nutrition and Population Health.
- have met the English and academic entry requirements for entry into their selected course
- not have accepted any other Deakin scholarship or bursary
- meet an overall equivalent WAM of 65% in their bachelor degree.
