# Deakin Warrnambool scholarships

As a Deakin Warrnambool student, you can take advantage of a range of generous scholarship opportunities. This is your chance to save on a world-class education in an engaging and welcoming environment. Submit your application today so that Deakin can help you achieve your career goals.

## Destination Australia Scholarships

The Australian Government's new Destination Australia scholarship program offers international students AUD\$15,000 per year to support study and living expenses.

To be eligible you must:

- be an international student studying on a valid student visa
- be a commencing student enrolled full-time at the Deakin Warrnambool Campus (on campus study) in Trimester 1 2020
- be studying a Bachelor of Commerce, Bachelor of Nursing, Bachelor of Environmental Science (Marine Biology), Bachelor of Education (Primary) or a research degree.

This scholarship is automatically awarded based on course offer, eligibility and selection criteria – no application is required.

The great news is, if you are the lucky recipient of a Destination Australia scholarship you will also be eligible for the Warrnambool Residential International Scholarship.

## Warrnambool Campus International Bursary

International students who study at Deakin's Warrnambool Campus could be automatically considered for a 20% tuition and on-campus accommodation bursary.

To be eligible for this generous bursary you must:

- be a prospective on-campus international student
- have applied to study a Bachelor of Nursing or Bachelor of Commerce at Deakin's Warrnambool Campus
- have met the English and academic requirements for entry to their selected course
- not have accepted any other Deakin scholarship or bursary.

No application is required. All prospective students who apply for eligible courses at Deakin's Warrnambool Campus will be automatically assessed for the bursary and will be advised of the outcome.

## Warrnambool Residential International Scholarships

International students who study at Deakin's Warrnambool Campus will be automatically considered for a 50% on-campus accommodation scholarship.

To be eligible for this generous scholarship you must be:

- an international student
- a commencing student enrolled at the Deakin Warrnambool Campus (on-campus study) in Trimester 1 2020
- living on-campus at Deakin Residences Warrnambool
- studying a Bachelor of Commerce, Bachelor of Nursing, Bachelor of Environmental Science (Marine Biology), or Bachelor of Education (Primary).

No application is required. This scholarship is automatically awarded based on eligibility and selection criteria. However, there are limited numbers available – so be sure to get your course application in soon so you don't miss out.

## Australian regional post-study work rights

The Australian government has recently announced the creation of new Temporary Graduate Visas, which will be available to graduates from regional universities from 2021. This incentive means that eligible students can receive up to two extra years of post-study work rights – allowing them to live in Australia for four years after completing their study.

With our campus in the regional town of Warrnambool, Deakin is one of the leading Australian universities able to offer this opportunity to students like you.
