Academic Merit Scholarship

Recipients of a Navitas Academic Merit Scholarship will be entitled to free tuition (equivalent to the maximum of up to four academic courses) for their second trimester of studies of a Griffith College Diploma or Associate Degree.

The scholarship excludes any additional costs required as part of the academic program including travel or materials such as books or equipment.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be a continuing (current) student, enrolled and studying towards a Griffith College Diploma or Associate Degree.
- · Be currently studying full-time.
- Have achieved competencies in all courses across their current program (for which the scholarship is applied for) in the trimester prior to being eligible for the scholarship.
- · Not have any outstanding fees on their student account.
- Not have previously received a Navitas scholarship or bursary, or had a scholarship or bursary from Navitas withdrawn.
- The scholarship applies to the second semester of enrolment only or the final semester of study for a Diploma or Associate Degree program. Students are liable to pay for any additional courses undertaken.
- Successful recipients will not receive any money from the Navitas member institution. The value of the scholarship will be recorded on the student's account during their second trimester of study for a Diploma or Associate Degree program.
- Scholarship recipients must maintain satisfactory academic progress through their second trimester of study to retain their scholarship.
- Scholarships are not transferable to other students or Navitas member institutes in any circumstances.
- Navitas member institutions reserve the right not to award all or some of the scholarships in a given year.
- · Scholarships cannot be backdated.

Navitas Family Bursaries

The bursary is equivalent to 10% of tuition fee for the first attempt at units in the program of study (ie. Certificate, Diploma, Bachelor degree, Pre-Master's program/PQP or Master's degree with a Navitas member institution (excluding mixed English option) and is credited to the eligible student's tuition fee account each semester (the amount being relevant to the number of units undertaken in that semester).

Eligibility

- Family Bursary applies where two or more students from the same family study at a Navitas institution.
- The first family member can be studying at a Navitas institution at the same time as the other family members or may have studied at any Navitas institution previously.
- The family bursary is granted to the second and subsequent family members who study at a Navitas institution.

International Student Merit Stipend

To assist international students with expenses during their studies with JCU, a partial scholarship may be offered. It is based on academic merit and will provide the lucky recipients with monthly payments of AUD\$700, provided a strong GPA is maintained each semester, as outlined in the scholarship offer.

Conditions:

- Recipient must be able to provide evidence of past academic excellence and must continue to show this throughout their studies with JCU.

You do not need to fill in a form or apply separately for this scholarship. The scholarship offer will be sent to you with your course offer letter. Simply accept your course offer and you will also be accepting the scholarship.

All applicants for the Diploma of Science, Diploma of Technology, Diploma of Nursing and Diploma of Engineering are eligible for the scholarship.

Conditions:

- The scholarship is available for JCU College Diplomas only and is not transferable to any other course at JCU. The scholarship applies only to 8 units of study within the course. Subject to the terms and conditions attached.
