

USF INTERNATIONAL ADMISSIONS SCHOLARSHIP UPDATES

AS OF APRIL 20, 2020 FOR FALL 2020 STUDENTS

Due to the impact of COVID-19 and consequent cancellations of the March and June SAT tests, we have:

- Extended our application and completion deadlines
- Adjusted the minimum GPA criteria

Students who have been awarded an admissions scholarship will be eligible for award upgrade consideration—this will take place over the next few weeks. The original application submission deadline of February 15, 2020 has been extended to March 15, 2020. Any student whose application was submitted by March 15, 2020 will be automatically considered for admissions scholarships. All required application materials must be received by the Office of Admissions by the June 1, 2020 completion deadline.

** Please note that these scholarship criteria and deadline extensions are ONLY for students applying for Fall 2020 and does not apply to any other future terms.**

APPLICATION SUBMISSION: MARCH 15 // APPLICATION COMPLETION: JUNE 1

Application Completion means all required documents and/or supplemental materials must be received by USF by June 1. For Freshmen, this includes but is not limited to official SAT or ACT scores as well as high school transcripts. For Transfer, this includes but is not limited to official transcripts and proof of English Language proficiency.
