



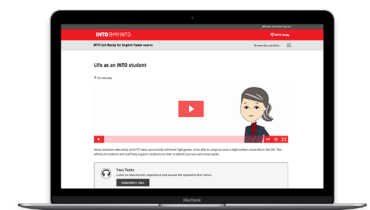

Am I eligible?

- Students starting a two-term academic course between February and May 2020 are also eligible.
- Exclusions include: Newcastle University London degrees, INTO University of Stirling courses, INTO Manchester Foundation courses, INTO Manchester in partnership with The University of Manchester Foundation courses, General English and Direct Entry.
- Students who have already confirmed their place are not eligible.
- Students must be self-funding. Sponsored students are not eligible.
- To qualify, you must confirm your offer and pay your deposit by the published closing date.
- You must quote 'Prepare2020' when you confirm your place.
